## *Robert Maclean - Tribune Pictures Ltd*

Robert founded Tribune Pictures Ltd in July 2016 to develop, finance, produce and distribute high-quality feature films for global theatrical markets, television content for cable and streaming audiences.

Tribune Pictures' initial slate of projects include feature film "*Across The River and Into The Trees*" based upon the Novel by Ernest Hemingway with director Paula Ortiz and featuring Liev Schreiber, Josh Hutcherson, Matilda De Angelis, and Danny Huston. "*In the Hand of Dante*" a film by Julien Schnabel starring Oscar Issac, Gal Gadot, Jason Momoa, Gerrard Butler, John Malkovich, and Al Pacino and is currently in post-production.

Robert began his film career in Paris, France where he financed and produced a number of award-winning feature length documentaries for Canal Plus and Channel 4 on London, including "*The Last Sailor's*", and "*Gold Lust*", presented and narrated by Orson Welles. In 1998, Robert founded and acted as Chairman of Internet Studios, an online business-to-business search engine and content distribution platform. He is an investor in the alternative energy sector as founder and CEO of Tribune Capital Partners.

Previously serving as Head of Production at RKO Pictures Inc, Robert financed and produced "*Criminal Law*", directed by Martin Campbell starring Gary Oldman and Kevin Bacon and distributed by Tri Star Pictures, *Digger* with Leslie Nielsen, Olympia Dukakis, and distributed by Paramount Pictures. MacLean also produced "*Bright Angel*", based on the novel by Richard Ford, which featured Dermot Mulroney, Sam Shepard, Lily Taylor, and Bill Pullman, and was released by Hemdale Films.

Robert had acted as executive producer on numerous independent pictures as well as television projects for ABC, HBO, and has arranged production financing, banking, and tax shelters for third party projects.

Robert currently divides his time between London, Los Angeles, and Italy.
